NFPA Fluid Power Clubs Treasurer Responsibilities

- Each NFPA approved Fluid Power Club must appoint a Treasurer.
- Fluid Power Clubs receive an annual stipend of up to \$2,000. The Treasurer will be responsible for managing the annual stipend and submitting a report to NFPA at the end of the school year as to how the money was used. If we do not receive this report, your club will not be eligible to receive the annual stipend of up to \$2,000 in the following school year.
- The Treasurer must send the university's W-9 to NFPA before the stipend will be processed.
- The stipend check will be made out to the university. Treasurer is responsible for letting NFPA know where to send that check and making sure that money is available to the club.
- Eligible expenses are:
 - Materials for fluid power projects
 - Catering for events / meetings, especially those involving NFPA industry members. (Alcohol will not be covered)
 - Travel to NFPA member company for tour/lecture
